CiQUS is launching the 1st Edition of the CiQUS Mobility Grants for International Postgraduate Students.

OBJECTIVE

The aim of this initiative is to reinforce the internationalization of the Master's Program in Chemistry at the Interface with Biology and Materials Science (ChemBio&Mat) at the University of Santiago de Compostela (USC). Closely linked to the cutting-edge research carried out at the CiQUS center, this program offers students a unique opportunity to engage in interdisciplinary scientific training at the forefront of chemistry, biology, and materials science. Through the launch of a new grants program, we seek to attract talented international students who are eager to pursue advanced studies in a dynamic academic and research environment, and to become part of a vibrant scientific community with global impact.

THE MASTER'S DEGREE

The ChemBio&Mat Master Degree is the only programme recognised as a unique degree in the Galician University System. It is a **full-time 90 ECTS Master's programme** (high number of practical ECTS to be trained in the most advanced experimental techniques), taught in **English** and aimed at providing multidisciplinary scientific and technological education in chemistry and its interface with functional materials and with molecular and cellular biology.

WE OFFER

2 mobility grants for international students, to study the Master's Degree in Chemistry at the Interface with Biology and Materials Science that is being developed at CIQUS in the 2025-26 academic year.

ENDOWMENT

13,500€ in 3 payments for accommodation and meals + up to 1,000€ annual payment for travel assistance.

REQUIREMENTS

- Non-Spanish nationality.
- Bachelor's degree, engineering degree or equivalent, obtained from an institution outside Spain (MECES level that qualifies for access to the Master's program).
- Average grade (equal to or greater than 8 out of 10).
- Accreditation of English level (minimum B1).

AWARD CRITERIA

- Average grade
- · Curriculum vitae
- Motivation letter
- · Personal interview for short-listed candidates

APPLICATION PROCESS AND DEADLINE

Applications must be submitted through the *Electronic Office of the University of Santiago de Compostela**, using the application form available, attaching:

- Scanned copy of the BSc diploma and academic record of the studies which provide access to the Master's Programme (with expression of the average mark based on 10) or document certifying the equivalence.
- · Curriculum vitae
- Motivation letter

Deadline: July 10, 2025 at 23:59h (CEST)
